"This additional step supports the production of power from renewable energy sources and places more renewable energy onto the grid."

The amount of credits purchased is the result of a comprehensive audit of the company's entire supply chain for the Essay of Clues collection. Not only are renewable energy credits and carbon offsets being purchased for the actual production of the carpet, Shaw is also offsetting the energy consumption of the entire upstream process. This includes the energy necessary to extract and refine oil, the polymerization and extraction process and more.

Adds Stephens, "Essay of Clues is a high performance cradle-to-cradle product. It is a flooring solution that customers can feel good about. At that end of its useful life, Shaw will even collect the product and recycle it into more backing and fiber at no cost because we want the product back. It is a service that provides savings and convenience to our customers while bringing usable materials back to Shaw."
